#### Buckle Up; This Year is off to a Roaring Start

Our Guest Speaker is the quintessential "man who needs no

introduction". Former Department of Veterans Affairs, Director of the National Cemetery System, and Perpetual Companion of the Dallas Chapter, Captain Allen Clark has taken pen in hand and is writing Volume 1, of what may become a trilogy of books.



Volume One is tentatively titled: "Soldier's Blood and Bloodied Money". It deals

with arms merchants, politicians, media, international bankers, and their involvement in our wars. This first book will consist of the warfare waged between good and evil; and then, relate some little-known facts, beginning with the American Revolution and proceeding to the Banker, Banana, and Oil wars, in Latin America (including a description of the manner in which Dwight Eisenhower achieved his meteoric rise in rank to five-star General of the Armies).

Allen graduated from West Point in 1963 and served in



Vietnam as a Military Intelligence officer, assigned to the Fifth Special Forces Group, involved covert operations against Cambodia. On June 17, 1967 he was severely wounded at Dak To Special Forces camp, in the Central Highlands.

He spent the next 15 months in hospitalization for treatment after amputation of both of his legs below the knees. He was awarded the Silver Star for Gallantry in action, a Purple Heart, Bronze Star for valor, Air Medal, and the coveted Combat Infantryman's Badge.

Allen was a Special Assistant to Texas Governor Bill Clements and served in the Administration of President George W. Bush. In 2011, he was named Outstanding Veteran of the Year by the Texas Disabled American Veterans association.
